Philemon 1

- ¹ Paul, a <u>prisoner</u> of Jesus Christ, and Timothy our brother, unto Philemon our *dearly* beloved, and <u>fellowlabourer</u>,
- ² And to our beloved **Apphia**, and **Archippus** our <u>fellowsoldier</u>, and to the <u>church</u> in thy <u>house</u>:
- ³ <u>Grace</u> to you, and <u>peace</u>, from God our Father and the Lord Jesus Christ.
- ⁴ I <u>thank</u> my **God**, making <u>mention</u> of thee <u>always</u> in my <u>prayers</u>,
- ⁵ Hearing of thy <u>love</u> and <u>faith</u>, which thou hast *toward* the Lord Jesus, and toward *all* <u>saints;</u>
- ⁶ That the <u>communication</u> of thy <u>faith</u> may become <u>effectual</u> by the <u>acknowledging</u> of <u>every</u> <u>good</u> <u>thing</u> which is in you in <u>Christ Jesus</u>.
- ⁷ For we have *great joy* and <u>consolation</u> in thy <u>love</u>, because the <u>bowels</u> of the <u>saints</u> are <u>refreshed</u> by thee, brother.
- ⁸ Wherefore, though I might be *much* <u>bold</u> in Christ to <u>enjoin</u> thee that which is <u>convenient</u>,
- ⁹ Yet for <u>love's</u> sake I rather <u>beseech</u> thee, being such an one as Paul the <u>aged</u>, and now also a <u>prisoner</u> of Jesus Christ.
- ¹⁰ I <u>beseech</u> thee for my son **Onesimus**, whom I have <u>begotten</u> in my <u>bonds</u>:
- ¹¹ Which in <u>time *past* was to thee <u>unprofitable</u>, but now <u>profitable</u> to thee and to me:</u>
- ¹² Whom I have <u>sent again</u>: thou therefore <u>receive</u> him, that is, mine *own* <u>bowels</u>:
- ¹³ Whom I would have <u>retained</u> with me, that in thy <u>stead</u> he might have <u>ministered</u> unto me in the <u>bonds</u> of the <u>gospel</u>:
- ¹⁴ But without thy <u>mind</u> would I do <u>nothing</u>; that thy <u>benefit</u> should <u>not</u> be as it were of *necessity*, but *willingly*.
- ¹⁵ For perhaps he therefore <u>departed</u> for a <u>season</u>, that thou shouldest <u>receive</u> him *for ever*,
- ¹⁶ Not now as a <u>servant</u>, but *above* a servant, a brother *beloved*, specially to me, but how *much more* unto thee, both in the <u>flesh</u>, and in the Lord?
- ¹⁷ If thou <u>count</u> me therefore a <u>partner</u>, <u>receive</u> him as myself.
- ¹⁸ If he hath <u>wronged</u> thee, or <u>oweth</u> thee <u>ought</u>, <u>put</u> that on *mine* <u>account</u>;
- ¹⁹ I Paul have <u>written</u> it with mine *own* <u>hand</u>, I will <u>repay</u> it: albeit I do <u>not</u> say to thee how thou <u>owest</u> unto me even thine *own self besides*.
- ²⁰ Yea, brother, let me have joy of thee in the Lord: <u>refresh</u> my <u>bowels</u> in the Lord.
- ²¹ Having <u>confidence</u> in thy <u>obedience</u> I <u>wrote</u> unto thee, <u>knowing</u> that thou wilt also do *more* than I say.

Philemon 1

- ²² But withal <u>prepare</u> me also a <u>lodging</u>: for I <u>trust</u> that through your <u>prayers</u> I shall be given unto you.
- ²³ There <u>salute</u> thee **Epaphras**, my <u>fellowprisoner</u> in **Christ Jesus**;
- ²⁴ Marcus, Aristarchus, Demas, Lucas, my <u>fellowlabourers</u>.
- ²⁵ The grace of our Lord Jesus Christ be with your <u>spirit</u>. *Amen*.
